

LITERACY

The children will begin by looking at Poetry. We will read and respond to a selection of poems that use similes and other simple images to create a vivid picture for the reader. We will then write our poem based on a model. Secondly we will look stories with an historical setting. We will plan, tell and write stories set in the past. We will include detail to evoke the historical setting; sequence events clearly and show how one event leads to another.

NUMERACY

During weeks 1 and 2 we will be covering counting and understanding number; knowing and using number facts; calculating and using and applying mathematics. The children will be introduced to the calculator as a way of checking their calculations. Our next block will cover securing number facts and understanding shapes. We will investigate number patterns and relations; develop skills in addition and subtraction; solve word problems and develop an understanding of the properties of polygons.

SCIENCE

Moving and growing

We will be learning about how the skeleton is related to movement and support in humans and what happens to the skeleton and muscles as they move. We will also be comparing human bones and skeletons with those of other animals.
