- Key vocabulary built into every lesson



## Accessibility:

- Our curriculum is fully inclusive and our highly skilled staff support all children in accessing the whole P.E. curriculum
- Adaptation of equipment, games, rules, support enables all pupils to participate
- Pre-teaching of P.E. vocabulary



## Diversity:
