



Desert Island Homework Project

In Geography this term, we are learning about maps. For your homework project, we would like you to create a map of your own island and complete some written activities to go alongside this. Below is a week-by-week overview – please try to complete each activity. The hand-in for completed projects is **Thursday 10th December.**

Week 1

Design your own island, and create a map. Use symbols, abbreviations and grid references to make the map clear and organised.

Week 2

Write a description of the island. You can do this in the first-person as a diary entry, or as a descriptive paragraph. Remember to use the non-negotiables you have been using in class (subordinate and relative clauses).

Week 3

Imagine you have been shipwrecked onto the island. Create a 'message in a bottle' asking for help!

Week 4

Create a leaflet to advertise the island as the next top holiday destination. Use powerful persuasive language to convince people to visit.

Week 5

Write a short (no more than 500 words) journey story set on your island. Create tension and excitement to make your reader want to read on.
