



It is expected that children in Year 6 spend about 30 minutes per night on their homework.

Homework will be put onto Google Classroom every **Friday** and the children will have a week to complete it. I will mark and return it by the following Thursday.

We would expect the children to have a go at their Reading, Maths and Spelling activities each week. The Topic homework ideas are additional, if you want something different.

READING

Every child has a reading book and should be reading daily week and then complete their Reading Log which is put weekly on Google Classroom. If they can read to an adult once or twice a week that would be helpful but we understand not all children like to do this. Instead they should be encouraged to read independently most days.

Discussion points could include:

- Summarise what you have read
- What themes could you identify?
- Define specific words and explain their impact
- Find examples in the text of...
- Why did character do/say specific things?
- Why did certain events happen and what were the consequences?
- Explain what you think will happen next and find the evidence that supports your answer

TIMES TABLE ROCKSTARS and SPELLINGS

Children should be visiting TTRS and practising their spellings several times a week.

MATHS and READING ACTIVITIES

Children will be given weekly Maths and Reading homework to complete that supports the Year 6 curriculum – it isn't necessarily linked to what we have been doing in class however it will give the children the chance to consolidate and practise key skills and to build on their previous learning. These will all be available weekly on Google Classroom.

TOPIC – The Victorians

Our History topic this term will be Victorian Children and this provides the inspiration for our Topic Homework. Of course if any of the children feel inspired to create or research something linked to either History, Science, or any other curriculum area, we would be delighted to see it.

- ICT - Find out about a famous Victorian and present your findings.
- DT - Find out some foods the Victorians liked to eat and use these to design a menu for a Victorian café.
- DT - Cook a favourite Victorian recipe and take a photo or bring it into school!
- DT - Make a 3D object or building from Victorian times.
- Art - Draw or paint a picture of a scene from the Victorian times e.g. Queen Victoria on the throne, a matchbox girl out on the street, a poor family eating dinner.
- Creative Writing - Imagine you are living in Victorian times, what are you inspired to write?
- Topic – find out more about Queen Victoria or the British Empire. Create a family tree or a labelled map.
