## Fundraising totals

A huge thank you to everyone who supported our ice lolly sale this week. We have used the money from our ice lolly and sweet sales to purchase some new playground equipment for the children to use at lunchtime. This includes new bean bags, hula hoops, skipping ropes, ankle skips, catch cups and table tennis paddles. We have raised £107.35 from our last non-uniform day, a huge thank you to all parents for your support with these events.

## Meeting Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May

Our meeting last night discussed our current finances and how we are supporting the school with their wish lists. We have agreed that we will pledge £250 for each class, every year, for teachers to use on some educational 'extras'. Teachers will choose how to spend this money to best support their class.

In addition to this we will continue to purchase the book bags for the new Reception children, fund the Christmas gifts delivered annually, re-stock playground toys every summer (just purchased), and support the purchasing of team sport kits (we have just funded Team Emersons Hoodies).

Alongside these shorter term goals we will be supporting the school's longer term plans with a percentage of our monies being saved for this—the current project is the main corridor timeline mural.

## Timeline Mural

At recent meetings we have discussed the funding for the Timeline. The Timeline will provide children with a detailed history of their world spanning the corridor of the school. This is a real passion project for the school but is a significant cost. To meet the needs of the school and respect the views of the parents, the PTFA has agreed to fund this project as a long term project. We currently have £630 raised from parent donations (you can still donate via Parent Pay) and we are planning to put £1000 towards it in July.

We will be hosting a car boot sale on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June. Cars can arrive onsite at 8am with us opening to pedestrians at 9am.
