#### 2 Impact Report

CM (Maths):

When the report was submitted there was a lot of data missing but this has now been updated. `

Key things TTRS, now accessible for VI children. More battles between classes. There are increasing number of children you see weekly as they have not been on TTRS, either too busy or that they forget to go on TTRS, question if we are reminding them enough of the importance? The older children see the value to them but not sure if the younger children do.

Consistency across the classrooms, using lesson structure. The children now know how they are involved in the lessons.

Data: All good until you reach year 6.

Year 1, there are a few that are lower, but these are SEND children or children who came into the school with a low level. Year 2 are doing well. Year 3 we need to be mindful but as a whole doing well 80% expected. Year 6, 61% expected plus. Initial glances those who didn't get it had a low arithmetic score. We are looking at arithmetic's with year 5 to see where they are in comparison. We are on the beginning of our journey but not at the end. MC, has any of the other schools felt this and the lower figures? SB, of the ones we have seen we are lower. National is 71% and target was 86% but that was set pre covid. We were 69% last year, it is a declining trend. A number of schools have had a declining trend, so we are not alone with that. We need to do more unpicking on the arithmetic results. Everyone who didn't achieve it got less than 20 on the reading. When we look at arithmetic's with year 5, would expect to see more than half reach 20. SB 61% is an urgency, and this has been made our priority to look into and deal with. Greater depths are also quite low at 7% as 32% is what we should be aiming for. JD, good to know where we are and that we have an aim of what to work towards. GL (English): Phonics and Reading – selection of reading with children across all classes. TA's observations, really positive and they have found it very useful and felt comfortable being observed and have seen it as a benefit. Real team effort. Reading Strategy has been produced, covers everything. Data: EYFS 83% achieved early Learning goals. Phonics screening year one: 87% passed. Real positive and massive improvement from last year. Year 2: 77% achieved. Year 3,4,5 70-80%. Year 5, looking very strong. Year 6: 75% expected plus and 18% greater depth, lower than what we are used to. Some children missed it by one mark. 14	SB: End of year data report – surmise and give an end of year position. Bottom line EYFS looking good.  KS1 data looks strong. No red flags there really.  KS2: Maths and Reading are low. Above national but way below what EGPS should be getting. Some of this is cohort specific but confident we will get this back to where it is meant to be. 61% in maths will raise a red flag with Ofsted. SB, we need to move quickly to get this back to where we should be.  Attendance: Good news attendance is recovering. Was 96% and that is where we want to get back to. Attendance has picked up. Persistence absence 13% of the school population. National is 19%. one day or fortnight.  PP has gone up. LM, one child that is new to us who is included in those figures is why the numbers have jumped. Target is 96%. Persistent absence down to 6%. NS, what is the norm among other LEAF schools? SB, different across the board. Blackhorse 1% higher, Bromley Heath 96%, Mangotsfield 97%. It depends on the community.  SB, side deal with LEAF, LEAF will pay for the group room to be kitted out/decorated as they will use it as a trustee group room. We will get a completely kitted out boardroom with high quality equipment for free.
