

MIGHTY EGPS SHINES AT LEAF REVIEW

On Wednesday this week we were visited by Mrs Kitchen, Director of Education for The Leaf Trust, and Mr Vaughan, an experienced school leader and inspector.

The team spent time talking with leaders about safeguarding, the new school vision and values, our reading strategy and our curriculum offer. They went on to spend time in classrooms sharing learning experiences with children, listening to individuals read, talking with children about the behaviour and feelings of safety in our school, and spent time in the playground soaking up the inclusive nature of our wonderful school.

Whilst there are things we continue to develop, there were a great many points of celebration throughout the day:

- They saw consistency in application of strategies to support effective teaching and learning: strategies we developed last year such as active participation, quizzing of prior learning, sequencing of learning.
- Children were able to talk about our school values of Kindness, Bravery, Respect and Empathy
 and the team saw these being lived by all throughout the day.
- Leaders are ambitious and determined in their pursuit of excellence for the school and the community which it serves.
- Children spoke confidently about feeling safe and know that there are adults in school that will help them if they need it.
- The value and passion the school community has for reading both for academic gain and pleasure is evident across the school and, when taken on a reading tour, the Yr6 children explained that "reading is highly valued at EGPS".
- Our whole school curriculum has purpose and ambition for all learners and teachers use the well-sequenced 'core knowledge' to deliver lessons that enable children to gain knowledge.

It was a supportive and positive day for team EGPS and left us clear in the knowledge that what we have identified as our next steps in the School Development Plan are absolutely correct.
