

# WELCOME BACK TO TERM 2

Well here we are at the start of a busy but fun-filled term! Christmas will be upon us in no time but there is lots to enjoy before then.

This term we are learning...

**Reception**—Will be learning about different festivals and celebrations. We are learning about Bonfire Night, Diwali, Birthdays, Hanukkah and Christmas. This week children have learnt all about Guy Fawkes and why we celebrate Bonfire Night.

Year 1— Are learning all about 'Seasons'. We will be learning about the changes in each season, writing seasonal poetry and investigating daily weather patterns.

Year 2—Will be continuing to learn about Kenya in Geography and Habitats in Science. This will also link to our DT project, where we will design and make African animal glove puppets.

Year 3— Are learning about 'Volcanoes and Earthquakes' in Geography and 'Forces and Magnetism' in Science. In addition to this, we will be creating our own healthy sandwich in DT and learning to play netball in PE!.

Year 4—Are learning all about electricity in Science, making circuits using components. For our DT project we will then plan and make a light up card, using our knowledge of circuits. Later on this term, we will be going swimming and our Geography topic is finding out all about the Welsh valleys.

**Year 5**— Are exploring coasts in geography, looking at sea defences and erosion. They will be refining their painting skills through the work of Constable, Gainsborough and Monet.

**Year 6**— Are turning into Historians and looking back into the past. For the first two weeks they are exploring WW1 and the origins of Remembrance in readiness for the Remembrance Assembly. Then they go a little further back in time to the Victorian Period where they are focussing on how children's lives changed during the reign of Queen Victoria.
